(iii) Special care should be given to guide our scholars to present research papers.







(ii) Revision done and Remedial classes taken really helped them a lot to prepare well for the semester examinations in a better way.







(i) Based on the aptitude and efficiency workload was allotted and the papers were divided among the teachers. Time-tables were framed for all the classes.







(ii) The students Rally conducted in support of the proper utilization of the right to vote, was a good success. The people belong to this area too got benefitted.







(ii) Awareness programmes on the prevention of chickun kunya fever and Dengu fever were conducted.






